# **Empowering Excellence: Cultivating Growth Through Faculty and Staff Professional Development**



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## Background

- In 2022, the University of South Carolina College of Pharmacy created a formal professional development (PD) committee consisting of eight faculty and staff members representing the College units.
- The committee's mission is to offer diverse educational programs and resources to support the ongoing professional development of faculty and staff, beyond the requirements of ACPE accreditation standards.<sup>1</sup>

# Objectives

- 1. Develop programming for faculty and staff.
- 2. Conduct a structured faculty orientation for new faculty and staff.
- 3. Increase the knowledge and awareness of the pharmacy profession among faculty and staff.
- 4. Create best practice documents for being a successful chairperson and a quality course coordinator.

#### Methods

- Conducted a needs assessment survey for faculty and staff professional development (PD).
- Collected recommendations for commonly used PD resources.
- Planned PD programming based on survey results.
- Divided committee tasks, including creating best practice documents and evaluating new faculty orientation.
- Identified the need for a formal staff orientation process.
- Used a Blackboard organization page to organize PD resources and content.
- After two years, distributed a survey to assess the effectiveness of PD programming.





#### Results

- 61 unique attendees (in-person/virtual) for 2023-24 events
- 68.5% of intended attendees
- 38 faculty members, 23 staff members
- 244 total attendees (147 in-person, 97 virtually)
- Average of 2.4 events per person (range: 0 to 12)
- 26 people responded to the survey (29.2% response rate)
- All 4 new faculty members who completed the last Orientation indicated that the content met their needs.

#### **Overall**





27% of respondents were unaware of the available Blackboard resource page.

### Conclusions

 Overall, faculty and staff have expressed great appreciation for professional development opportunities provided over the past 2 years. Feedback from the survey will be utilized to plan for the next academic year.
