# Background

- In 2021, Northeast Ohio Medical University (NEOMED) College of Pharmacy (COP) dedicated 0.2 full-time equivalent (FTE) to new Director of Professional Development (DPD) and 0.2 FTE to new Director of Interprofessional Education (IPE)
- In 2022, new DPD for College of Graduate Studies was added at NEOMED

### Actions

- Created IPE professional development workshop for NEOMED COP faculty and staff with partner health profession institutions
- DPD collaborated with University and College of Medicine faculty development directors to convert semiannual Celebration of Medical Education workshop into interprofessional event promoted as Celebration of Health Professions Education

# Objective

 To review how NEOMED COP created faculty development opportunities related to IPE

# Accomplishments

- Since 2022, IPE professional development workshops have occurred annually and exposed COP faculty to IPE activities with their partner institutions
  - June 2024: 24 attendees from five institutions
- Topics have included interdisciplinary team building, interpersonal effectiveness, development and assessment of IPE activities, and artificial intelligence in medication education
- University team has successfully hosted six joint event covering topics that included creating effective learning objectives, mapping assessments to lecture and course learning objectives, and implementing effective curriculum design
  - April 2024: 69 attendees from NEOMED
- These workshops have also highlighted faculty contributions to scholarship of teaching and learning
