

Academy of Consultation-Liaison Psychiatry Case Conference Webinar Series: Stoudemire Award

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BACKGROUND

In the advent of COVID-19, virtual options for collaboration in educational endeavors greatly expanded among institutions. Through the Academy of Consultation Liaison Psychiatry (ACLP) Residency Education Subcommittee a webinar series was formed that allowed showcasing of ACLP's special interest groups (SIG), subcommittees, and individual expertise via a Case Conference Webinar Platform.

METHODS

A systematic approach was used for panelist selection, content creation, advertisement dissemination, practice session coordination, DEI integration, live webinar moderation, and social media sharing. Planning occurs 4-5 months in advance of the live webinar. Webinar structure includes: moderator introduction, trainee case presentation, expert discussant lecture, and question/answer session. Webinar metrics are followed including: number of registrants, returning registrants, live webinar attendance, geographic location of registrants, level of training of registrants, and YouTube views after posting.

DISCUSSION




